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## FAQs For Patients

### 1. What is a Patient Specific Implant(PSI)/Device?

Answer: Patient specific implants or devices are custom made appliances which are designed to match the anatomy of the patient. These can be placed inside/outside the body of the patient in a particular region by a trained physician/surgeon; just like regular (also known as “stock”) implants.

### 2. Are Patient Specific Implants safe?

Answer: Although the performance of implants in general are dependant on a multitude of factors, Patient specific implants are as safe as their “stock” counterparts and in most cases may be even better performing and safer in the long term due to their conformity to the natural anatomy.

### 3. Will using patient specific implants ensure reduced recovery time?

Answer: Complete recovery from any surgery or medical procedure is a time consuming process and the recovery from the same is dependant on a number of factors. The use of PSI in general may or may not directly be related to improvement or deterioration in the recovery time from the procedure. Kindly consult your doctor for a more detailed discussion in this regard.

### 4. Are PSI economical?
